Every Sunday 7:15 a.m. HBC Sunday Morning Sociable Meet on City Island in the parking lot near the Walnut Street Bridge for a casual 8-10 mile ride, followed by optional breakfast at Roxy's Café, 274 North Street, HBG. Helmets required.

Every Sunday May 6 – May 27

1:00 p.m. Capital Area Greenbelt Ride
This 18 mile ride starts on the Greenbelt behind the City Line Diner, 3302 Derry Street, HBG. The pace is very casual. We'll show points of interest along the way, such as SAMBA's mountain bike trails and the 5 Senses Garden. Helmets required.

Sat. May 5 – Explore West Shore

9:00 a.m. Meet at West Shore Plaza, Lemoyne, across from Karns. Ride 15-20 miles at a 10 mph pace through several West Shore communities. We will stick to low traffic roads as much as possible while hitting the highlights along the way. Lunch option at the West Shore Farmers Market afterwards. Helmets required.

Sun. May 6 – Garden Faire at Fort Hunter Celebrate spring at Garden Faire, Fort Hunter Park's charming, free event on Sunday May 6, 10am – 4pm.
